Wheelchair Foundation

The World Health Organization estimates that tens of millions of people in the world are in need of wheelchairs and cannot afford them. Our mission is to deliver wheelchairs to children, teens and adults who lack mobility due to disease, accident, war or advanced age thereby creating awareness of this worldwide need. These people and their families will have their lives instantly changed, being able to go to school, work, worship, or just outside for the first time in years, or ever. A wheelchair means Hope, Mobility and Freedom.

The Wheelchair Foundation distributes wheelchairs in the country of destination with approved distribution partners, who identify the recipients, and then properly seat them in their new wheelchairs. The consignee for these containers is responsible for customs and importation charges, duties, container charges, etc. The consignee can either arrange to have these services and fees donated or pay for them themselves.

Knights are encouraged to organize, and to participate in a wheelchair distribution at their own expense. Experience the joy of changing a person's life with the gift of a wheelchair!

Container Sponsorship

If you are interested in a specific country and/or wish to participate on a distribution trip, consider sponsoring an entire container of 100 to 280 wheelchairs. Smaller donations will be combined with other donors to make up a complete container.

The cost to sponsor a 20-foot container of wheelchairs is:

\$16,500 for 110 wheelchairs with solid rubber tires or 100 wheelchairs with mountain bike tires

The cost to sponsor a 40-foot container of wheelchairs is:

\$42,000 for 280 wheelchairs with solid rubber tires or 260 wheelchairs with mountain bike tires
